World Para Swimming Rules in Appendix B of the Swimming Canada Rules will apply except as modified in this meet package for Para swimmers.

All participants in this event are reminded that they are bound by Swimming Canada's and Swim Saskatchewan Policies including but not limited to, the Code of Conduct and Ethics, Athlete Protection Policy, Social media policy as found in the Swim Sask's Safe Sport manual, which can be found [HERE](#)

Rule Highlight on Misconduct Rule Provisions:

Effective September 1, 2026, Rule C2.3.2.1 of the July 2026 rule book or (C2.5.2.1 of new rule book if published) will be enforced. Misconduct may include deliberate or negligent spitting, spouting water or blowing the nose in the pool or on deck immediately before the start; deliberately kicking or striking the starting platform or back plate; and unsafe or uncontrolled entry into the pool. - 1 X 25M Competition Pool
- No Warm-Down Lanes Available
- There will be no backstroke starting ledges available at this swim meet. There will be no Starting Blocks Available for the 25M Events.

8. Eligibility:

- Entries will only be accepted for swimmers currently registered with a Swimming Canada or World Aquatics affiliated club. Canadian Para Swimmers must have a valid classification listed on the Swimming Canada website: [Classification – Swimming Canada](#). Foreign Para Swimmers must appear on the [World Para Swimming Classification Master List](#)
- Swimmers must be a minimum of 7 years of age as October 17, 2026
- PARA swimmers who are registered with Swimming Canada or a World Aquatics affiliate are eligible to compete.
- **This swim meet is a closed invitational, open to Clubs: GOLD, LASER, PASS, BKSC, MRSC**
- **As of September 1, 2026, swimmers ages 13 years and older must be below the Swim Saskatchewan 'A' Time Standard (SC or LC) to be eligible to enter into Saskatchewan Racing Series swim meets.**
- **Athletes aged 13 and older who achieve a Swim Saskatchewan 'A' Time Standard (SC or LC) after September 1, 2026, will be eligible to compete in Saskatchewan Racing Series swim meets.**
- **Any 13 and older eligible athlete who achieves a Swim Saskatchewan 'AA' Time Standard will not be eligible to compete in that event(s) at the Saskatchewan Racing Series.**
- This meet is combined with a Masters swim meet.

9. Qualifying:

- There are NO qualifying times for this swim meet.

10. Entry Fees:

- Age group swimmer surcharge \$8.00 plus \$10.00/event.
- **Fees are to be paid via e-transfer to the Saskatoon Goldfins Swim Club – payments@goldfins.ca**
 - All entry fees are to be paid by Wednesday, October 14, 2026
 - No swimmer/team will be permitted to start warm-up until entry fees have been paid.

12. Entry Limit:

- Age Group swimmers are limited to entering three (3) individual events.
- This meet is an open development swim meet.
- The meet will accommodate a maximum of **160 age group swimmers**. Once the swim meet reaches ~150 registered swimmers, the next complete team to register will also be accepted.
- Additionally, 40 Masters swimmers will be included.
- Entries will be processed on a **first-come, first-served** basis, determined by the date and time the entry file is uploaded.

13. Entry Process:

All entries must be submitted via the Swimming Canada Online Entries System. All swimmers must have a status of Active in order to pass validation. No entries will be accepted by email.

All Attending coaches and support staff must be listed when uploading entries to the National Registration System (REMS). If a coach from the same club as swimmers registered will not be attending the meet, the coach must provide the Meet Manager with the name of the coach and club that will be responsible for coaching their swimmers.

Coach Registration Information: The Swimming Canada coach registration policy states that all coaches attending any sanctioned competition must have a minimum NCCP coaching status.

- i. Entry times are to be entered as Short Course Only (SC) only.
- ii. Converted times will NOT be accepted. If a swimmer does not have a SC time, then they are to be entered with NT.
- iii. No Time (NTs) entries will be accepted.
- iv. Please contact Jennifer Robinson if you have any further questions regarding entries.

14. Relay Entries:

- There will be no relays offered.

15. Deck Entries:

- Deck entries may be allowed at the discretion of Meet Management and only if space permits; additional heats will not be created.
- **Deck entry fee:** \$15.00 per event.
- Deck entries and fees must be submitted by **8:30 AM**.
- Deck entries **do not** count toward a swimmer's maximum of 4 individual events.
- **Deck entries are for additional swims for swimmers that have already entered the competition and have passed registration validation, to swim additional swims in empty lanes. Deck Entries are not for day of competition entries.**
- *Please note that deck entries are not for day-of-competition requests.*
- All deck entries will be considered "exhibition" and will not be scored.

16. Meet Format/Competition

- All events will be offered as Timed Finals.
- All events will be offered as Mixed events per Swimming Canada Rule C5.1.1.10 (July 2026 Rule book)
- There are no PARA-specific events or entry standards.

17. Seeding:

- Events will be senior seeded and swum slowest to fastest,
- Para swimmers will be seeded according to their entry time.

18. Start

- Starts will be conducted from Starting Platforms (blocks) as per World Aquatics Rule II.4.1 and 11.15.1.4
- Starts will be conducted from the Deck or Bulkhead as per Canadian Facility Rule II.C4.1.1 and II.c15.1.4.1 or C4.1.1 of the July 2026 rule book.
- In-water starts will also be allowed and will be conducted as per Canadian Facility Rule II.C4.1.1 and II.C15.4.1 or C4.1.1 of the July 2026 rule book.
- Starting Platforms (blocks) will only be available for events 50m and greater.
- 25m events will start from the 25m bulkhead.
- There will be no backstroke starting ledges available at this swim meet.

d/Deaf or Hard of Hearing Accommodations

This competition can provide the following accommodation's for swimmers who are d/Deaf or Hard of hearing:

- Non-verbal instruction provided by a support person who is registered in the Swimming Canada Registration system as Support Staff and has a status of "Active". Support Staff must be included in the club's event entry.
- Visual Start hand signals given by the starter/referee

Clubs are to contact Meet Management prior to the competition to discuss accommodation's.

19. Scratch Process:

- **Coaches will be sent a Coach Contact Form Link.** This form must be completed by **Friday, October 16, 2026 – 12:00 PM.**
- Coaches will be provided with the scratch form link(s) to scratch their swimmers from the swim meet and/or from specific events.
- Scratches will be submitted electronically. All scratches must be submitted by **8:25 AM.**
- Scratches simply create empty lanes, as there will be no re-seeding.
- Scratches may be made at any time without penalty except for loss of entry fee.

20. Scoring:

- Age Groups for Scoring/Awards:
 - Female & Male: 10 & Under, 11 – 12, 13 & Over
- Scoring for award purposes is under review and will be presented to Saskatchewan Coaches through Technical Bulletin updates.
- 25M distance events will not be scored.

21. Awards

- Award(s) categories/presentation is under review by Swim Saskatchewan. Award categories and processing procedures will be presented to Saskatchewan Coaches through Technical Bulletin updates as soon as the information becomes available.

22. Results

- Results will be published as per the age categories listed in #20 above.
- Official results will be uploaded to the Swimming Canada Online System (REMS) following the completion of the competition.
- Unofficial results will be made available during the event on the Meet Mobile app.

23. Official Splits

- Official split requests must be submitted to Meet Management a minimum of **30 minutes** prior to the start of the session.
- The team requesting the official split may be required to provide additional trained timers to help take the official split.

24. Officials

- Officials Registration Deadline: Tuesday, October 13, 2026.
- Register at: [2027 Saskatchewan Racing Series #1](#)
 - Complementary hospitality will be available.
- Anyone attending is encouraged and welcome to register as an official and/or volunteer at this swim meet.

Officials Attire:

- Timers and Chief Timer – White Shirt, Black Bottoms and black shoes that can get wet and are safe to walk in on the pool deck.
- All other officials – Red Shirt, Black Bottoms and black shoes that can get wet and are safe to walk in on the pool deck.
- No hats please.

25. Meet Safety Rules

- Lanes will be available for diving **20 minutes** from the end of the warm-up session.
- There will be separate warm-up lanes for Masters Swimmers and Age Group Swimmers. Meet Management will assign lanes.
- A Para swimming lane may be designated based on coach request. Please contact the Meet Management to make this request.
- The specifics of the lane assignment will be communicated in the Technical Bulletin a minimum of three days prior to the start of the swim meet.

26. General or Facility Information

- Any changes to the meet format will be shared with the coaches in the Coaches Technical Bulletin that will be emailed to attending coaches prior to the start of the swim meet.
- Glass containers and breakables are not allowed on the pool deck.
- No deck changing will be allowed. Swimmers must use the changing rooms. Swimmers who change on deck may be removed from the competition.
- The Goldfins Swim Club will not accept responsibility for lost or stolen items. It is the responsibility of each swimmer entered into the swim meet to ensure their personal belongings are stored in a secure manner.
- Only swimmers, coaches and officials are allowed on the pool deck. Spectators must remain outside of the pool area or in the upstairs bleachers

29. Photography/Videography

- In order to minimize risk, all photographs and video taken at Swimming Canada/Swim Saskatchewan sanctioned competitions, whether taken by a professional photographer or videographer, spectator, team support staff or any other participant, must observe generally accepted standards of decency. Under no circumstances are cameras or other recording devices allowed in the area immediately behind the starting blocks during practice or competition starts, or in locker rooms, bathrooms, or any other dressing area.

- Clubs may appoint one official photographer for their club to be granted access to a designated area/working deck. Please contact Meet Manager prior to the competition for permission.
- Meet Management may issue an accreditation/name tag identifying such person. If a tag is issued; then it must be worn at all times.

Safe Sport

- Swimming Canada and Swim Saskatchewan believe that athletes, coaches, officials, support staff and volunteers have the right to participate in a safe and inclusive sport environment that is free of abuse, harassment, and discrimination.
- Swimming Canada is dedicated to providing a safe and inclusive environment, which involves promoting Open and Observable Environments. This means making meaningful and concerted efforts to avoid situations where a coach/official/staff member, etc. might be alone with an athlete. All interactions between an athlete and an individual who is in a position of trust should normally, and wherever possible, be in an environment or space that is both 'open' and 'observable' to others.

All participants in this event are reminded that they are bound by Swimming Canada's Policies and Procedures.

Swimming Canada would like to remind coaches and their athletes that deck changing is strongly discouraged. Athletes are asked to please use the facility's change rooms, or on-deck changing tents if available. Coaches are asked to discourage deck changing and help keep the sport safe for everyone involved.

Only participating swimmers, officials, registered coaches, and authorized people are allowed on deck.

Swimwear

All swimmers are permitted to race with the swimwear of their choosing at all competitions sanctioned by Swim Saskatchewan. It is not required to declare the choice of swimwear to the Referee if the fabric of the swimwear is a permeable open mesh textile and would not reasonably be seen to create a technical advantage in terms of speed, buoyancy, or endurance.
